Concurrent Enrollment

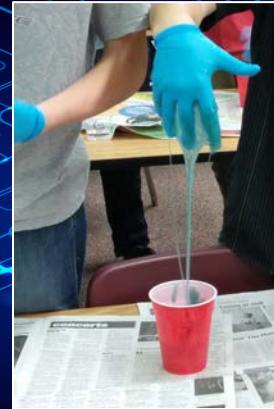
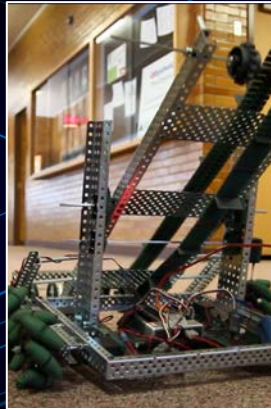
What is Concurrent Enrollment?

- An option for high school students to earn college credit and high school credit concurrently
- Face-to-face classes taught by UVU-approved high school teachers using college curriculum
- College credits earned are transferrable to most state colleges/universities
- Students may earn all or part of an Associates degree through CE classes
- 95% of ALC classes are CE

UVU LIVE-INTERACTIVE

What are Live-Interactive Courses?

- Another way to earn CE (college/high school) credit
- Necessary to complete an Associates while in High School
- Broadcast in real-time to ALC classrooms
- Taught by UVU professors
- Credit is transferrable to most state colleges and universities
- Over 25 courses offered
